What is it?

Today, we are going to explain to you what Lazomun is!

This is a role play which consists of pretending that each member is part of the UNO or the UN (the United Nations).

The project is in partnership with Lycée des Lazaristes (Lyon). It will last 6 months until February 2026.

There will be many events during this period. The main event is a conference at the lycée des lazaristes from 7th to 9th February. Then, on 30th April, all the Louis Querbes students involved in the project will go to the headquarters of the UN and to the Red Cross Museum in Geneva.





Several teachers and directors will contribute: Mrs Taillandier and Mrs Ducharne organize it, Mrs Leite and Mrs Dominici help the members of the British and Spanish press.

In order to take part in this project, Year 10 pupils must apply by submitting their application. They are then selected by Mrs Taillandier. Once the pupils have been accepted into the project, they discover their role which can be: President / vice - president / country representative / member of the British or Spanish press.

Next, they are split into different committees to defend their country's interests during the conference.

This year the School Conference will focus on 3 topics:

- Ensure the rights of Indigenous peoples in the Amazon
- · Fight misinformation on the Internet
- Ensure the safety of navigation in the Black Sea
